

# clinical educator certificate

Clinical education is a responsibility of many health care professionals. This newly updated clinical education certificate prepares, challenges and enhances required knowledge and skills in clinical education and supervision. Effective clinical education and supervision provides invaluable experiences for future health care providers.

These three workshops (six hours each) plus the Clinical Educator Certificate Assignment are designed specifically for health care professionals. The Clinical Educator Certificate is relevant for clinical educators, mentors, preceptors and health care professionals who work with students. Providing foundational knowledge, skills and applied techniques, this certificate will optimize your clinical teaching and supervision experience.

## Module 1 (PD721): An Introduction to Teaching and Learning in the Clinical Setting

This workshop combines lectures, small group work and practical exercises to familiarize you with the principles of teaching and learning in a clinical setting.

### Learning Objectives

- Discover the principles of adult learning and individual learning styles
- Understand diversity and inter-generational learners
- Discuss effective clinical teaching strategies
- Give effective feedback
- Develop briefing, debriefing and reflective practice skills
- Understand competency based evaluation

## Module 2 (PD743): Evaluating Learning in the Clinical Setting

Building on PD721, this workshop will enhance your development as a clinical educator in the area of evaluation.

### Learning Objectives:

- Discover the principles of the learning cycle model to evaluate professional competencies
- Explore formal and informal methods of evaluation including documentation that can be applied in a standardized way
- Identify regulatory, legislative and organizational policies affecting competency-based evaluation

## Module 3 (PD747): Coaching and Mentoring in the Clinical Setting

Building on PD743, this workshop will enhance your development as a clinical educator in the area of coaching and mentoring students for success.

### Learning Objectives:

- Explore the responsibilities and roles of coaches and mentors
- Integrate coaching and mentoring principles to support performance
- Discover coaching and mentoring techniques to enhance performance

## Module 4 (PD813): Clinical Educator Certificate Assignment

Successful completion of the Clinical Educator Certificate requires attendance at all three clinical educator workshops and a passing grade in the evaluative assignment in PD813.

- PD721 Introduction to Teaching and Learning in the Clinical Setting
- PD743 Evaluating Learning in the Clinical Setting
- PD747 Coaching and Mentoring in the Clinical Setting
- PD813 Clinical Educator Certificate Assignment

The evaluative assignment provides you with the opportunity to integrate the knowledge and skills of all three workshops. Information about the evaluative assignment will be forwarded to you upon payment of the registration fee.

A certificate of attendance will be issued upon completion of individual modules.

Transcript and Clinical Educator Certificate will be mailed out after successful completion of all modules.
