



The Paris Orthotics Clinical Education Scholarship

Program Eligibility:

Available to full-time students who are enrolled in the Chiropractic program and who, through his/her clinical education, have demonstrated leadership and excellence in the clinical setting.

Criteria:

Nominees will have clearly demonstrated the following:

- Leadership in the clinical setting
- Clinical excellence in Podiatric Bio-mechanics.
- Success in maintaining an overall 'B' average or better
- Consistence in exhibiting professional behaviour in both academic and health care settings, shown a commitment to improving the lives of others, as illustrated by the ability to work effectively both as an individual and in an interprofessional team providing collaborative patient centered care
- A financial need.

Bursary Amount: 2 annual scholarships @ \$1000.00 each,

- One award will be given in the winter term for a student who has completed semester 1 of year 3. This new award will be first granted in February, 2009.
- One award will be given in the fall term for a student who has completed year 2. This new award will be first granted in the fall of 2009.

The 3rd year scholarship recipient will receive the award amount in February of each year but will be formally recognized at the annual Awards Ceremony during the following fall or winter term.

To Nominate:

Nominated by a Clinical Coordinator, Clinical Adjunct Professor, Clinical Educator, a Clinical Liaison Officer and/or a Michener faculty with a clinical teaching assignment.

A type-written and signed nomination, not exceeding 250 words, outlining why the student is eligible for this scholarship based on the above noted criteria.

Only the successful nominees will be notified.

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION: February 15th for the 3rd year award and August 31 for the 2nd year award.
