

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY:

Named in recognition of Michener Student Council and Michener students, this endowed bursary fund has been established to support their fellow students at The Michener Institute beginning in 2005-2006 academic year.

CRITERIA:

- Available to full-time students with demonstrated financial need
- Students must have demonstrated a caring and sensitive attitude and a have genuine interest in helping people
- Students should have a good academic standing and will have made a contribution to their program and/or student life at Michener.
- Bursaries are available for qualified students entering the second or third year of their program.
- Students must apply annually.

BURSARY AMOUNT:

Four annual bursaries of \$1,000.00 each. (Additional bursaries may be given out as the endowment fund increases through additional contributions)

TO APPLY:

Applicants must submit:

- One-page written application outlining why s/he is eligible for the bursary based on the above noted criteria
- A completed [budget form](#) (available in the Financial Aid Office) providing evidence of genuine financial need.
- Bursaries are awards whose main criterion is demonstrated financial need. Whereas academic standing, student involvement, attitude and interests as well as their contribution to the program are factors in selecting a bursary recipient, financial need is the most relevant factor.
