

Adjusting Your Browser's Pop-up Blocker:

Pop-up blockers on most popular internet browsers, toolbars and Internet security packages interfere with the operation of the Virtual Classroom (it is considered a pop-up window). To correct this issue, you will need to adjust all pop-up blocking software on your computer to allow pop-up windows from Michener's Blackboard.

Note: Unfortunately, Michener cannot provide instructions for every pop-up blocking product available. This document will provide instructions for Microsoft Internet Explorer and Mozilla Firefox only.

To Adjust the Pop-up Blocker in Internet Explorer 6 and 7:

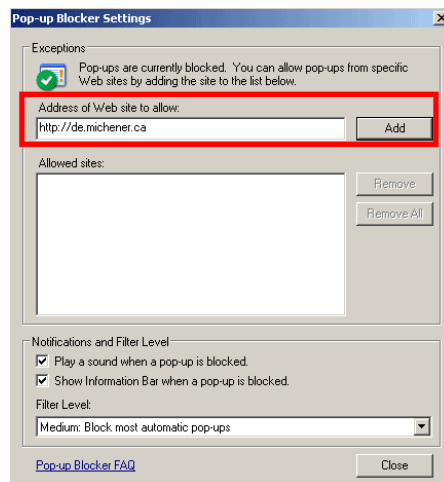
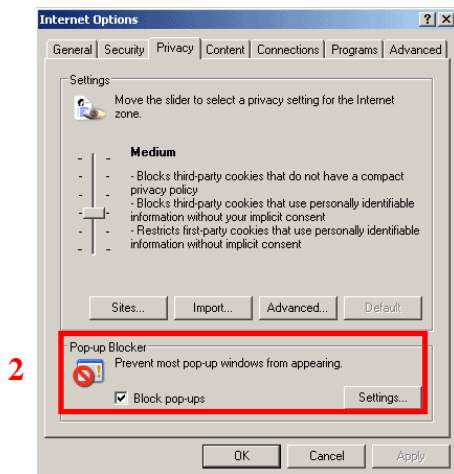
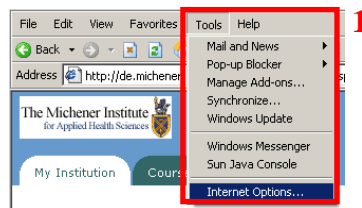
1. Click on "Tools"

2. Select "Internet Options"

3. Click on the "Privacy" tab and click the "Settings" button in the Pop-up Blocker section at the bottom of this window

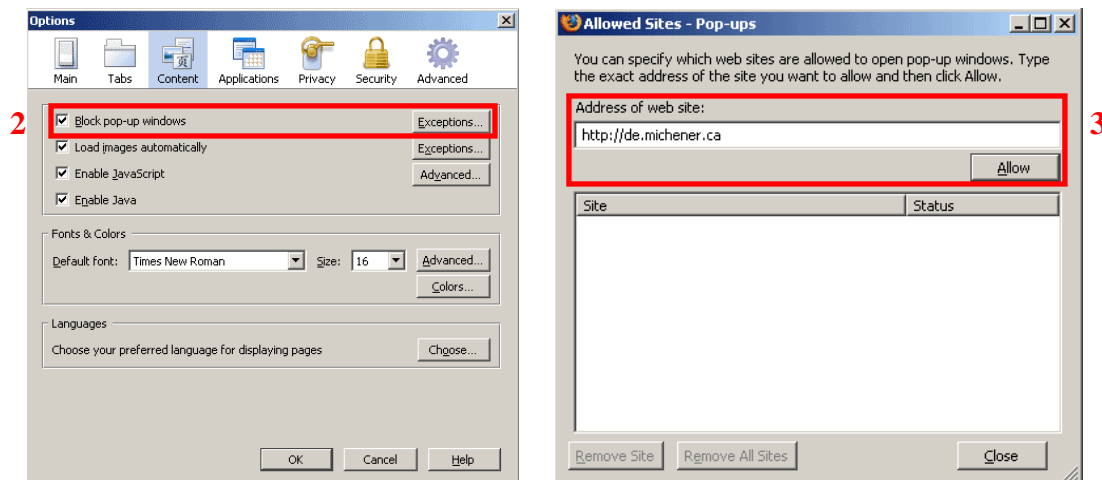
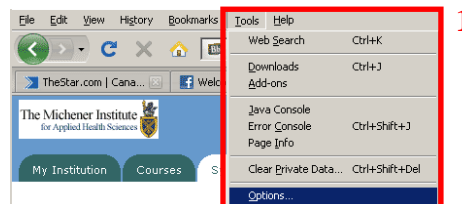
4. Where it says "Address of Web site to allow", type <http://michener.blackboard.com> and click the "Add" button

5. Click "Close" in the bottom right corner of the Pop-up Blocker Settings window, then click "Ok" in the Internet Options window



To Adjust the Pop-up Blocker in Mozilla Firefox:

1. Click on “**Tools**”
2. Select “**Options**” and select the “**Content**” tab
3. Click on the “**Exceptions**” button next to the “**Block pop-up windows**” check box (make sure there is a checkmark in this check box as well)
4. Where it says “**Address of web site**” type <http://michener.blackboard.com> and click the “**Allow**” button
5. Click the “**Close**” button in the bottom right corner of the “**Allowed Sites – Pop-ups**” window then click “**Ok**” in the Options window



You may have several pop-up blockers installed on your computer including the Google and Yahoo Toolbars as well as your Internet security software. If this is the case, you will have to adjust all of them to allow pop-up windows from <http://michener.blackboard.com>.
